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is the skill of hearing the difference between bat and mat and understanding that changing the /b/ sound in bat to an /mmm/ sound can create a different word.

Phonological and phonemic awareness refer to spoken language — the understanding that the sounds of spoken language work together to make words. Phonics refers to the alphabetic principle — the idea that letters represent the sounds of spoken language.

## **Phonemic Awareness, Concepts of Print, Letter Knowledge ...**

Phonemic awareness refers to the specific ability to focus on and manipulate individual sounds (phonemes) in spoken words. Phonemes are the smallest units comprising spoken language. Phonemes combine to form syllables and words. For example, the word 'mat' has three phonemes: /m/ /a/ /t/.

Teachers call these two skills phonological and phonemic awareness. Kids can practice these skills through rhyming (words with the same ending sound) and alliteration (words beginning with the same sound). They can put sounds together to make words and take words apart.
